Inside has also received a bit of attention with carpet and chair cleaning. Still a couple of other jobs planned.

Another positive move is the establishment of a working group consisting of Dean Shephard, Ken Viney, Olliver Reidel, Chris Sturzaker, Geoff Dyke and Mark Smith who are working on the future plans for the club - a possible synthetic green and facility improvements.

At the present time through the Treasurer, Mark Smith's careful direction and close attention to what has been available through the Government Stimulus Package our finances have not suffered by being closed, in fact, they're looking quite healthy.

The **Special General Meeting** to vote on the Management Restructure has had to be delayed at least until after July 15th as gatherings are restricted until then. In the weeks prior to that date members will receive full documentation to enable them to study the details before the meeting, either sent by email or hand delivered by Board Members.
